- Items needed:
  - o Monetary
    - Cash (checks payable to Buffalo County CASA)
    - Gift cards (WalMart, Target, Visa, etc.)
  - Donated <u>new</u> items
    - Fleece blankets
    - Books
    - Stuffed animals
    - Backpacks, duffel bags, small suitcases
    - Card games and board games
    - Puzzles, Lego sets (smaller to mid-sized)
    - Coloring books (child and teen) with markers or colored pencils
    - Self-care items (soft fuzzy socks, hair clips, etc.)

Consider items that would be comforting to children who have experienced abuse, neglect, and trauma. These children/teens are often removed from an environment rapidly, with little time to collect personal items. Having new items provides a sense of ownership for the recipient.
